CALL TO ORDER

Robert Pellegrino, Northampton Township, Vice-Chairman convened the meeting of the Bucks County Tax Collection (TCC) at 4:25 PM and led the Committee in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

ROLL CALL

Eileen M. Bradley, New Britain Township, Treasurer called the membership roll. There was a quorum to conduct the Committee business.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A motion was made and seconded to approve the May 30, 2013 minutes. On vote to approve the minutes, the motion carried unanimously.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Ms. Bradley noted there were no expenditures for the period, with the YTD expenditures totaling \$15,195.46. A motion was made and seconded to approve the Treasurer's report for the month of August. On vote, the motion carried unanimously. With the 2013 annual Assessments received from Keystone, there is \$55,631.05 remaining in the account.

Ms. Bradley presented a Proposed 2014 Budget, calling for no assessment for 2014. The 2014 Budget would be voted on at the next meeting, scheduled for November 26, 2013.

SOLICITOR'S REPORT

***Update on Litigation Regarding Philadelphia "Super Credit"***

Solicitor Geoff Beauchamp advised the Committee that there had been no word yet on a decision from the Pennsylvania Supreme Court on the Philadelphia Super Credit Appeal.

OLD BUSINESS

Mr. Joseph Lazzaro, Esq. of Keystone Collections Group reported that collections will continue to flow more quickly with Keystone being the sole collector and filers becoming more familiar with the process. He stated that delinquent collections were underway, with most jurisdictions' taxpayers receiving letters within the next few weeks.
